



Current Rate Schedule

The membership process is broken into two distinct readings, a 1st and 2nd Reading. At each reading Membership applications are submitted to the Board of Governors, which typically occurs at a monthly Board meeting. When submitting the completed profile, all nominees requiring stock purchase will need to submit a check payable **Lakeside Park, Inc.**, and all nominees requiring an initiation fee will need to submit a second check payable to **Jefferson Lakeside Country Club**. After receiving the completed Nominee Profile, the candidate will be given a temporary membership account that will allow them access to all club facilities and activities granted to the membership category in which they are applying. The 2nd reading confirms permanent membership and the candidate will be notified immediately following the Board meeting.

Swimming Pool Fees

Any food & beverage will be charged to the members account. Guest must be accompanied by member. A guest fee will be charged to visitors using the pool areas, whether in the water or not. Weekly Guest Passes

Weekly guest passes are available for non-resident guests of members. These passes will entitle each guest to unlimited use of the swimming pool, tennis courts and golf course.
